## **Boathouse Rules for Bristol Empire Dragons**

1. All members must pay their subscriptions before using any club equipment.
2. Have the Captain's express permission to use equipment (including O1's and paddles).
3. Clean boats regularly.
4. Put boats and equipment away and keep the boathouse tidy.
5. Repair/report damage to any equipment to the club captains.
6. Lock all doors if you are the last person to use the boathouse.
7. Anyone found in breach of the above rules risks forfeiting their membership and use of any club equipment.

## **Safety Guidelines for Bristol Empire Dragons**

1. All members must be able to swim 100 metres unaided in light kit.
2. All drummers must wear buoyancy aids/lifejackets for all outings.
3. All accidents resulting in injury (however minor) are to be reported to the Safety Representative and noted in the club log book.
4. All paddlers are to take responsibility for their own and other's safety. All potential risks to health and safety are to be reported to the Safety Officer/Representative.
5. All paddlers should check equipment is in good order before venturing on the water.
6. All damage to be marked and reported.
7. All outings must be logged on the white board.
8. All harbour/river and club laws and bylaws shall be abided by at all times.
